New Parents, welcome to Hua-Hsing! Returning Parents, welcome back! Hua-Hsing Chinese School is a non-profit organization devoted to creating a safe challenging learning environment for students of all ages and ethnicities. Hua-Hsing Chinese School (HHCS) was founded in 1989 with the endorsement of Madame Chiang Kai-Shek, one of the most influential woman of the 20th century. Hua-Hsing has exemplified Madame Chiang's high values on the importance of education and culture awareness. We continue to strive for excellence each semester by maintaining a strong curriculum and hiring the best teachers.

Please note our school location is at **Jasper High School on Sundays: 6800 Archgate, Plano** (South of Legacy Dr. and Archgate Dr.) We thank you for reading and following below instructions for your child(ren).

Registration/School Guidelines:

1. Please make all check payments to: **H.H.C.S.**
2. Registration is only complete when payment is received and all information is completed. *Please write legibly. Email addresses are crucial. All notices are sent via email.*
3. Registration forms may be mailed to: **NEW ADDRESS: 7711 Worthing Street Dallas, TX 75252**
4. Classes are held on Sundays. Holiday breaks are in accordance with school district schedules.
5. Level Criteria for class placements (Placement tests are available for new students upon registering and payment of \$10 test fee):

Kindergarten:

1. Must be 4 ½ years and older (must be turning 5 on or before 1/1/08, **and**
2. Has a mature personality, i.e. can pay attention to the instructor for the entire class period, **and**
3. Must be able to write own name clearly and correctly, **and**
4. Must be able to follow oral directions and cooperate with other students.

L1:

1. Can **read and work independently** with minimum help from others, **and**
2. Have either successfully completed HHCS LK, or Is currently enrolled in 1st grade.

L2 and Above:

1. Have either successfully completed the previous HHCS grade level, or is currently enrolled in registered class.

1. **Returning Students:** upon completion of Spring semester prior, H.H.C.S. will send out letters of recommendation with the report card to propose next grade level placement. Recommendations are based on test performances, student's achievements, maturity, and capabilities.
2. **To promote or skip a grade:**
  - a. Must have completed successfully the previous level at HHCS. Average of 90 or above from all 4 of the major tests (Fall-midterm and final exam, Spring-midterm and final exam). Teacher recommendation is required.
  - b. Placement tests are available **until the 7<sup>th</sup> week of classes**, if above criteria is not met. One placement test attempt a year.
  - c. The highest level a student is allowed to skip is 2 levels above his/her current grade. For example, a 1<sup>st</sup> grader can attend only up to L3 at HHCS.
  - d. A student can only skip once per school year.
  - e. If skipping a grade during the semester, past class materials for new grade will not be provided.
3. **To transfer:** Request must be first submitted to Department Directors pending their approvals. **Transfers will be allowed until the 4<sup>th</sup> week of registered class date;** a \$10 transfer fee will be administered.
4. **Absence or missed class:** please contact the teacher when a student needs to miss a class. Parents will need to make arrangements to pick up the materials from the teacher on that day (or arranged day or friend pick-up). **Materials are not available in advance. The administration will not have requested teaching materials.**
5. **Withdrawal:** It is student's/parent's responsibility to officially withdraw from class. Class fees will be prorated on a base of 10 classes. **Withdrawals are not available after the 4<sup>th</sup> class of registered date.**
6. **Discriminate weather/Adverse conditions:** Class cancelations will be posted on website: [www.huahsing.com](http://www.huahsing.com)
7. Jasper High School **doors will be opened at 12:45 pm**, please do not drop your children off earlier, **they will be unsupervised.**
8. The School has ample parking spaces, please **park in the south entrance** as there are over 800 parking spaces. **North parking is for teachers and staff only.**
9. Parents are asked by PISD and HHCS to **not stay at the School while the students are in class per safety and security concerns.**
