2010 Math Contest Rules and Registration Form:

Please read the rules and eligibility below before completing registration form:

Our Annual Math Contest will be held each year in the Spring Semester for students of **1st to 7th grade**.

1. Competition will be held at **Jasper High School** on **April 17, 2010** (6800 Archgate, Plano TX 75024). Jasper has two parking lots, parents and family can only **park in the south larger parking lot**. North parking lot is strictly reserved for teachers and staff. Traffic Tickets will be issued for cars parked in fire zones.
2. Registration fee is **\$10 (check to HHCS or cash)**. **Registration must be received or postmarked before April 14, 2010**. 3. **Check-in for Competition begins at 9:30 AM. Students are not allowed in the classroom before 10:00 AM. Any student, who is not in the classroom by 10:15 AM, will NOT be in contention.**
4. **Contest begins promptly at 10:30 AM until 11:30 AM**. The time limit for the competition is exactly 1 hour. All complete and incomplete tests must be turned in by 11:30 AM. **Award ceremony to promptly start at 12:15 PM**. Trophies and prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. All competing students will receive good effort presents.
5. Students must be in the competition for their current grade level.
6. Once competition begins, students may not leave the classroom unless they have completed the test. If they must leave in middle of the competition, their test will be voided and not entered into competition.
7. Students may not bring any cell phones, calculators, book bags or personal belonging into the classroom. **Students must bring 2 pencils and an eraser.**
8. **If cell phones are used by the student at any time during the competition in the classroom, they are immediately disqualified.**
9. Parents are not allowed outside classrooms or hallways. Parents may wait in the cafeteria or designated waiting areas. **Please make sure your child knows where to find you.**
10. Winners are determined by speed and accuracy. First student to complete test accurately will win first prize.
11. In the event of a tie breaker: a) If the tied students both have completed their tests and have same scores, student who turned in the form to Moderator first wins. b) If the tied students do not finish their exams, we will take the result of the last 5 questions on the exam; whoever scores the highest on these questions will win. If there is a tie in the last 5 questions, we will then move to the next 5 and so forth. c) If there is no clear winner in the tied students scenario of a) and b) a tie breaker of 10 questions will be separately administered.
