Hua-Hsing Chinese School (HHCS) was founded in 1989 with the endorsement of Madame Chiang Kai-Shek, one of the most influential women of the 20th century. Hua-Hsing has exemplified Madame Chiang's high values on the importance of education and culture awareness. We know the key to our success is our partnership with our families. Thank you in advance for reading and following below details. We look forward to building a better stronger future together.

COVID-19 and our commitment: We returned to in person learning last school year to great success. We are thankful for our families in following our procedures and staying home when ill. Our classes will continue to be in person at **Jasper High School located at 6800 Archgate**, **Plano**. We take a genuine commitment in protecting our families and communities. We will continue to monitor all situations and communicate proactively and transparently with our families. Please note all communications are sent via email.

Registration/School Policies:

- 1. **Registration is online only:** Returning students: begins on Oct.29 10 A.M. with payment deadline Dec. 2nd 5 P.M. New Students: begins on Dec, 3rd 10 A.M. Click here for Registration portal link. Registration is only complete when online enrollment is completed, and payment is received.
- 2. Classes are held on Sundays. Some classes may have varied class time or additional office hours. Holiday breaks are in accordance with PISD school district schedules. Our school year is comprised of two semesters: Fall and Spring. Registration and fees are required for each new semester.
- 3. **Math class placement**: Students are to enroll in same grade level at their primary school. Registration system is set by the Texas grade eligibility. If your child's birthday does not match his/her actual grade, please email registration@huahsing.com. You will be asked for documentation I.E. primary school schedule or report card.
 - a. Kindergarten: Must be 5 years old on or before 9/1/23 (potty-trained)
 - b. Level 1 and above: Have either successfully completed the previous HHCS grade level or is currently enrolled in same grade level at primary school.
- 5. To promote or skip a grade:
 - a. Must have completed successfully the previous level at HHCS. Average of 90 or above from all 4 of the major tests (Fall midterm and final exam, Spring midterm and final exam). Teacher recommendation is also required.
 - b. If above criteria is not met, \$20 placement tests are available until the 4th week of classes.
 - c. The highest level a student is allowed to skip is 2 levels above his/her current grade. For example, a 1st grader can only skip to L3 HHCS.
 - d. A student can only skip once per school year. If skipping a grade during the semester, past class materials for new grade will not be provided.
- 6. **To transfer within grade level:** Request must be first submitted to Department Directors pending their approvals. *Transfers will be allowed until the 4th week of the registered class date.*
- 7. **Student Performance**: The completion of HHCS class and homework have a direct correlation to the student's success in HHCS. If the student does not progress due to incompletion of work, disengagement in class, unwillingness to learn and/or lack of improvement from parent/teacher/staff conferences, HHCS reserves the right to terminate student's registration. This policy is strictly adhered to protect the welfare of HHCS students and teachers.
- 8. **Absence or missed class:** Please contact the teacher when a student needs to miss a class. Parents will need to make arrangements to pick up the materials from the teacher on that day. *Materials are not available in advance and cannot be emailed*. The administration will not have requested teaching materials. A maximum of 4 absences are allowed per semester. Students who exceed four (4) absences without prior approval by school will be forced to withdraw without refund and receive a failing grade for the semester.
- 9. **Withdrawals**: It is student's/parent's responsibility to officially withdraw from class. Please see withdrawal form (found on our website) for deadline and details. *Withdrawals* are not available after the 4th week of the semester.
- 10. **Lost materials:** Outline and homework are students' responsibilities once they are passed out by teachers. Fees will be assessed for additional copies of materials.
- 11. Discriminate weather/Adverse conditions: Class cancelations will be posted on website: www.huahsing.com and emailed to parents.
- 12. **Safety:** Jasper High School **doors will be opened at 12:45 pm, please** do not drop your children off earlier, **they will be unsupervised.** Plano Police is on campus with us during school hours to patrol the exterior and interior of the school. Parents may stay on campus during class in the cafeteria. Unregistered students and families are not allowed in the hallways during class time. Please adhere to our requests and policies. Any behavior deemed reckless or dangerous by any family member may result in automatic expulsion.
- 13. The School has ample parking spaces, please **park in the south entrance** as there are over 800 parking spaces. **North parking is for teachers and staff only.** All traffic and parking regulations apply at Jasper. No parking in fire lanes. Tickets issued will be the sole responsibility of the offender. HHCS reserves the right to expel a student and remove family from the Jasper premise if the HHCS staff and/or Plano Police witnesses dangerous driving and improper driving.
- 14. Parents and/or Payers of student tuition will be responsible for any fees accrued by HHCS due to insufficient fund checks, returned checks or stop check fees.
- 15. In support of a conductive learning environment, all attending students must abide by the above-mentioned school policies and Hua Hsing Chinese School Code of Conduct, which includes a pledge of being a good digital citizen. By registering to become a student, student is acknowledging and agreeing to the Code of Conduct and being a good digital citizen.
