Dear Parents,

New Parents, welcome to Hua-Hsing! Returning Parents, welcome back! Hua-Hsing Chinese School is a non-profit organization devoted to creating a safe challenging learning environment for students of all ages and ethnicities. Hua-Hsing Chinese School (HHCS) was founded in 1989 with the endorsement of Madame Chiang Kai-Shek, one of the most influential women of the 20th century. Hua-Hsing has exemplified Madame Chiang's high values on the importance of education and culture awareness. We continue to strive for excellence each semester by maintaining a strong curriculum and hiring the best teachers.

**Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our Board of Directors and a special advisory board are assessing all options to provide the best safest options for our families. You will have the opportunity to select your learning preference. If your learning preference is announced unavailable, HHCS will refund your class payment per school withdrawal policy.**

### Registration/School Policies:

1. Registration is online only. Returning students: begins on April 18<sup>th</sup>- 10 A.M. with payment deadline May 15<sup>th</sup>- 5 P.M.  
New Students: begins on May 16<sup>th</sup>- 10 A.M. Click here for [Registration portal link](#).
2. Registration is only complete when online enrollment is completed, and payment is received on the registration website.
3. Classes are held online on Sundays. Some classes may have varied class time or additional office hours. Holiday breaks are in accordance with PISD school district schedules. Our school year is comprised of two semesters: Fall and Spring. Registration is required for each new semester.
4. **Math class placement:** Students are to enroll in same grade level as their primary school. Grade skipping or advancement is not offered for 2020-2021 school year. Registration system is set by the Texas grade eligibility. If your child's birthday does not match his/her actual grade, please email [registration@huahsing.com](mailto:registration@huahsing.com). You will be asked for documentation I.E. primary school schedule or report card.
5. **Online Tools and Applications:** For HHCS online classes, additional online tools and applications will be required. These application access will be included in your child's HHCS account. Instructions will be provided with online access guidelines. It is the student's responsibility (with the help of the parent as needed) to download the required tools. Homework and tests will not be graded or considered complete if done incorrectly.
6. **Student Performance:** The completion of HHCS class and homework have a direct correlation to the student's success in HHCS. If the student does not progress due to incompleteness of work, disengagement in class, unwillingness to learn and lack of improvement from parent/teacher/staff conferences, HHCS reserves the right to terminate student's registration. This policy is strictly adhered to protect the welfare of HHCS students and teachers.
7. **Online Absence or missed class:** Please contact the teacher when a student needs to miss an online class. *Materials are not available in advance or emailed.* Student will be counted unexcused absent if he/she is more than 15 minutes late for class. A maximum of 4 online absences and/or incomplete work are allowed per semester. Students who exceed four (4) online absences and/or incomplete work without prior approval by school will withdraw without refund and receive a failing grade for the semester.
8. **Withdrawals:** It is student's/parent's responsibility to officially withdraw from class. Please see withdrawal form (found on our website) for deadline and details. *Withdrawals are not available after the 4th class of the semester.*
9. Parents and/or Payers of student tuition will be responsible for any fees accrued by HHCS due to insufficient fund checks, returned checks or stop check fees.
10. In support of a conducive learning environment, all attending students must abide by the above-mentioned school policies and Hua Hsing Chinese School Code of Conduct, which includes a pledge of being a good digital citizen. By registering to become a student, student is acknowledging and agreeing to the Code of Conduct and being a good digital citizen.
